

### Explanation of the weight data: source Bürstner:

	<p>The mass in running order is determined according to VO (EU) No. 1230/2012. It refers to the basic version, including basic equipment (75 kg for driver, filled fuel tank to 90%, filled water tank in driving position with 20 litres, gas in an aluminium bottle to 100% and electrical connection cable). The mass in running order and the possible payload and number of persons can change with different engines or equipment variants and by fitting optional extras. Deviations within the factory tolerances are possible and permissible.</p> <p>The specified payload option depends on the empty weight and the mass in running order as well as the permitted number of persons. It is therefore reduced by the weight of the fitted optional extras according to the specifications and assumes a corresponding load distribution. The maximum load also takes into account the conventional load (according to the standard it is calculated as follows: 75 kg per passenger plus 10 kg for personal equipment/luggage per passenger and driver plus 1 kg per 10 centimetres of vehicle length) and the remaining load, which can be used for additionally attached optional equipment or additional luggage.
