



Over “Two Grand” raised as Mallory Park and RKB-F1 run “Taxi Ride” initiative for Grenfell Tower victims

At the fifth round of the Hyundai Heavy Industries British Sidecar Championship over the weekend of 8/9th July, more than eighty sidecar fans and “would-be passengers” tried the ultimate sidecar experience as they rode in the sidecars of top-flight championship contenders.

At £20.00 for two laps, crews were kept busy for one hour each day ferrying the excited passengers round the 1.3 mile Mallory Park circuit.

The total money raised was Two Thousand and Twenty Pounds, an astonishing display of generosity by the sidecar fraternity.
