The caterpillars should not be touched by humans or animals as inflammation or other reactions may occur. In addition, the facilities were not well kept in February 2011 and the campsite staff were unhelpful.</p> <p>Jan 11 - Site as described. Staff insisted that a guide was required when leaving site on foot.</p>
